

STEP 1

Attach the ice fountain using the metal coil found at the top of the champagne bottle neck. Release coil slightly, leaving enough room for the fountain to be inserted through. Pull the coil down into a horizontal position.

STEP 2

Insert the fountain vertically through the coil. Tighten and adjust the coil loop accordingly to fit safe and securely. This can be done by pinching the coil against the fountain.

STEP 3

Check the fountain is fastened securely to the side of the bottle. Hold the bottle at a slight angle away from spectators or any other obstructions. Light fuse sealing paper with a naked flame, hold at arm's length aiming away from body, other people and flammable materials.

STEP 4

Once the fountain has burnt out it must be removed by a member of staff and disposed in the correct manner. Extinguish within a bucket of ice or water and dispose when ready.

NOTE: Ice Fountains are flammable and should be treated with care. Whilst some fountains are deemed to be hand-held, we recommend they are operated by members of staff and disposed of correctly after use.

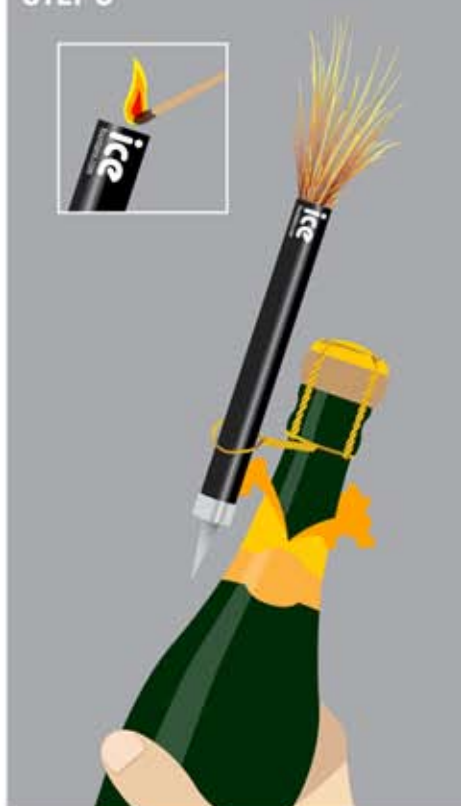
